Juniper Cygnet residents recovering from COVID-19

Five Juniper Cygnet residents who formerly tested positive for COVID-19 are now fully recovered.

Juniper CEO Chris Hall said this was welcomed news and families of the residents have been advised.

As at this morning, there are five residents and four staff who are COVID-19 positive at Cygnet, reducing the total number from fourteen people yesterday to nine people today.

Further PCR testing of residents will be undertaken tomorrow, Friday 18 February 2022.

All Juniper staff at Cygnet continue to receive Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) at the commencement of each shift.
